

DAY 1 — WELCOME

There's a chance that you are reading this because in the last few days or weeks, maybe even in the last few hours, you have said, "YES" to Jesus. CONGRATULATIONS that's a HUGE decision. Maybe you are still thinking about it, trying to decide what does it really mean? How do you trust God? How do you follow Jesus? What's it mean to be a Christian? What am I really saying "YES" to?

- Keep a pen and paper close by, and if something comes alive to you or you feel like God speaks to you through a verse, then write it down.
- Each day's reading will consist of 3 segments to make reading and understanding easier. (*Listen, Learn, Live*)

- **LISTEN —*What is God/Scripture saying?***

Write down the key phrase, sentence or word in the reading.

- **LEARN —*What does it mean for me?***

What is your reaction to this passage, phrase, sentence, or word or what question would you like to ask God?

LIVE — *How can I apply this to my life and live it daily?*

What do you feel God's reply would be?

What are some truths to obey?
